## 1. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Out of several academic institutions run in Nawalgarh, Smt. Godavaribai Ramdeo Podar Senior Secondary School is one of the Budding English Medium School, affiliated to CBSE Board in the region. In the beginning Podar school was affiliated to RBSE Ajmer in 1993 and according to the need of the time the management decided to have it affiliated to CBSE New Delhi in 2016.

On the demand of people of Nawalgarh, the Trust started a school for Toddlers in the name of "Smt. Snehalata K. Podar Tiny Toddler School" with air conditioned class rooms and modern amenities.

The Anandilal Podar Trust was established in the year 1921. We feel proud to state that the trust was founded by Shri Anandilal Podar who was inspired by great visionaries like Mahatma Gandhi, Founder Trustee Chairman; Bharat Ratna Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya, Founder Trustee and Chairman of the Trust from 1930 to 1946 till his demise and Shri Jammalal Bajaj as the Founder Trustee of the Trust.

Our former Chairman Shri Kanti Kumar R. Podar was a very dynamic personality and well-known nationally as well as internationally. He had been President of more than 15 important trade and industrial bodies, many of them are of international level. He had presided over the Institutions like FIICL, Indian Cotton Mills Federation, all India Organisation of Employers, Indian Merchants Chamber of Economics and Scientific Research Foundation etc. At the behest of the Government of India he formed the SAARC Chamber of Commerce and Industries, of which he had also been the President. He had been on the Senate of University of Bombay for 6 years. A new academic and cultural dimension has been brought by him to Nawalgarh Institutions.

### 4. INFRASTRUCTURE

#### (a) ATL

Atal Tinkering Lab is the flagship Initiative of Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), Government of India to cultivate an innovative mindset amongst high school students across the country.

Since 2021 our school is providing Atal Tinkering lab in campus to foster curiosity, creativity and imagination in students and inculcate skills such as design mindset, computation thinking, adaptive learning, physical computing etc.

#### (b) Smart Classroom: Lead Curriculum

To bring innovation at the core of the Education System we have started Lead curriculum in school. Lead curriculum is an integrated theme-based curriculum that follows a multi model approach to ensure holistic development of children. Through this curriculum the school provides latest technological teaching tools to the students. We have classrooms fitted with LED screens operated with tablets which contain specially designed syllabus content of all subjects for classes 1 to 8. Through Lead curriculum we emphasize on excellent learning outcomes for every child which enable them to have unmatched exposure opportunities and exclusive platforms.

**(c) Science Laboratories:**

The School has well equipped Laboratories (as per CBSE requirement) for Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology with the latest equipments for experiments up to class XII. The labs provide extensive opportunities for students to do practical work and conduct scientific investigations, nurturing the 'Learning by doing attitude' of the students. For instance the Mathematics lab provides the students with an opportunity to know the world of Mathematics in the form of various mathematical devices, models, charts and literature pertaining to the conception and growth of the subject.

**(d) Computer Science Laboratory:**

The school is equipped with an air conditioned Computer Science laboratory having latest configuration computers and the computers are connected to LAN with broadband internet facility. Wi-Fi facility is also available across the campus.

**(e) Sports:**

The school gives equal importance to all sports and games for developing healthy habits and channelizing the energy of the students. To nurture every sport with great zeal and sportsman spirit our school provides the facility of "Podar Sports complex". It is a huge playground with all sports equipments of Cricket, Football, and Volleyball along with indoor games such as Table Tennis, Badminton, Chess, and Carrom etc. For Tiny tots swings, slides and many more toys are also available in the school campus.

Development of physical strength of the students along with the overall growth is brought out by the value laden sports and games programme. Students develop qualities like leadership, healthy sportsmanship and loyal teamwork. The Annual Sports meet is a step towards encouraging the students to avidly participate in various events and display their aptitude for sports. The school also actively participates in various Inter School Athletic Meet and tournaments where students hoist their school flag bringing laurels to the school in these competitions.

**(f) School Band:**

Our school has its own band. The mission of school's band is to provide a quality music education to our students. Our goal is to develop quality through our focus on each individual performer. The students play instruments like Bass drums, Side drums, Snare drums, Bugle, Flute and Trumpet. Our band students enjoy and wear their band Uniform with pride and joy. The band is led by the band master holding a large Baton. It leads the march past during Annual sports and performs at other important functions at school.

We have a rich library with more than fifteen thousand books, periodicals, journals, magazines and encyclopedias. It offers reading room facility, display of latest arrivals etc. The books are issued to the students for a period of fifteen days. The library is enriched every year with the addition of new books. The adjoining Podar College provides 3rd largest library in the state.

**(h) Hostels:**

Separate hostel facility for boys and girls is available on the request made by the parents/guardians. The hostel rooms are properly ventilated and well furnished. Rooms with two bed three beds may be allotted to the students based on the availability. Desert coolers have been installed in each room. Neat and clean toilets with the facility of hot water during winter are the specialties of the hostel.

Nutritious and healthy vegetarian food is provided to all. Besides it, Aqua Guard fresh water is available for drinking round the clock. A proper and parent like care of the boarders by our wardens is a unique feature of our hostels which are guarded round the clock by vigilant security guards. The students staying in hostels should abide by rules and regulations of the hostel in addition to that of the Institution. There is an additional fee for living in the hostel. The students are required to fill and submit a separate application form for admission to the hostel. Students can deposit the cash which is available with cashier against fixed receipt.

## 6. ACADEMICS AND OTHER

- Emphasis is laid on learning by doing.
- Scholarships for meritorious students.
- Students are guided by the teachers to do their work themselves
- Student-Teacher ratio is 1:25.
- Extra classes are held regularly for the students needing extra help
- The school generates four versatile houses. Each house has a House Master and Coordinator from the teachers of the school. Students are chosen as Captain and Vice-Captain. Inter house quiz competitions, drawing competitions, chart making competitions and debate competitions etc. are held every Saturday for the personality and leadership development of the students.
- Prizes and awards are given to the students for their academic, sports and other achievements
- Inculcation of moral values in students is stressed
- Voluntary excursion and educational tours are organized regularly
- Spoken English classes are held regularly for all students

## OTHER ACTIVITIES

### (I) Music and Dance:

The school provides music and dance classes to students on request. We believe that such classes can bring out hidden talents and creativity of students.

### (II) Houses Division :

The students of the school are grouped in four houses. Every house is under the supervision of the house in charge. The responsibility of every house is to maintain school decorum and thus to inculcate a healthy, dynamic and disciplined environment in the school. There are four houses namely:

- (a) Gandhi House                      (b) Malaviya House                      (c) Podar House                      (d) Subhash House



### (III) Yoga:

The practice of yoga prevents and cures psychosomatic disorder and improves individual ability to fight stressful situation.

Our School offers Yoga classes to our students under the guidance of well-trained and experienced yoga trainer for enhancing concentration, mental health and making the students aware of the benefits of yoga.

### (IV) Books and Stationery:

The School has a policy of not selling any kind of books and stationery from the school store to students. However students are free to purchase stationery and books from outside.

### (V) Seminars and Workshops:

Seminars and workshops play crucial role in school. They ensure a proper flow of knowledge and information by skilled intellectuals and professionals. The school conducts Seminars and Orientation Programmes on various topics for students to develop their proficiency in verbal communication. It helps them in grooming their personality and ensure integral development of a child.



## 7. DRESS CODE

### Uniform for Girls :

Beige colour shirt, coffee colour skirt/ salwar suit, white socks, black shoes, tie and belt with school logo. A white uniform/inter house dress is to be worn on Wednesdays and Saturdays.



### Uniform for Boys :

Beige colour shirt, coffee colour half pants/trousers, white socks, black shoes, tie and belt with school logo. White uniform/inter house dress is to be worn on Wednesdays and Saturdays. A dark brown woolen blazer or pullover is compulsory for all students during winter.



## 8. TIMINGS OF THE SCHOOL

- The school runs from Monday to Saturday
- Summer timings : 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM
- Winter timings : 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- Parents can meet teachers on Saturdays from 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM

## 9. ADMISSION RULES

Admissions are done as per CBSE norms. All students are expected to fill in the application form. The admission committee reserves the right to accept/reject any of the application forms without assigning any reason thereof.

### Documents to be enclosed with application form

- Three self addressed postcards with the admission form.
- Original marksheet of the last qualified examination with Three photo copies
- ST/SC/OBC students should enclose certificate of their category
- Transfer Certificate must be attached to the application form at the time of admission.
- The parents must note that no change in date of birth will be possible without proper certificate of date of birth issued by the competent authority.

## 10. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

Discipline is an integral part of the learning process. The following are the rules to be followed in the school:

- (a) Students must arrive in the school at least 10 minutes before the first bell rings. Latecomers as well as those who were absent on the previous day must bring an application from the parents/guardians.
- (b) Every student must be habitually clean and neatly dressed. Hair must be well groomed and cut properly. The school uniform must be worn on all school days and at all school functions.
- (c) The students are strictly forbidden to leave the school premises during the regular school hours without the prior permission of the Principal.
- (d) The students must not litter the school premises and must not leave their books, stationery and other belongings around.
- (e) All text books, notebooks and necessary articles for the day's work should be brought by the student.
- (f) Every student must bring his/her school diary every day.
- (g) Every student is bound to observe good manners both inside and outside the school. Shouting / whistling / throwing things at others and any such unmannerly conduct is strictly prohibited.
- (h) Students shall not damage the desks and chairs. Scribbling or drawing on the walls or any school property is prohibited. Any damaged items that belong to other students, the school is not liable.
- (i) Books, Magazines, Newspapers shall not be taken out of the school library until and unless these have been duly issued.
- (j) Borrowing and lending of money and exchanging articles are prohibited.
- (k) Valuable articles like expensive watches, costly fountain pens, jewelry, mobile phones, MP3 players, etc. are not to be brought in the school campus. If they are lost the school cannot be held responsible.
- (l) Inside or outside the campus the students should not indulge in activities that may bring bad name to the school.
- (m) In case of insubordination to school authorities or gross misconduct, the management of the school has the right to take appropriate disciplinary action against the concerned students.
- (n) The name of any student may be struck off from the roll by the Principal of the school on account of:
  - (i) Nonpayment of fees and other dues by the due date.
  - (ii) Continued absence for ten consecutive days without information.
  - (iii) Continuous indiscipline even after three warnings.

## 11. EVALUATION, TESTS AND ATTENDANCE NORMS

The academic year maintains four periodic written tests. With the portion of syllabus cumulatively covered.

The annual examination will be conducted by the board for classes X and XII with 100% syllabus. For class X the board exam will carry 80% weightage and a student's performance in school tests will account for 20%. The student must secure 33% each in internal and final examination. "The student will have to secure pass marks in both school and board exams separately to get promoted."

Besides these above-mentioned examinations, routine class tests are also conducted at regular intervals. Annual evaluation is made on the basis of the whole year's performance of the students. It includes marks of periodic tests, notebook submission and subject enrichment activities etc.



## 12. PARENT-TEACHER MEET [PTM]

PTM is scheduled after every periodic test; marks of tests are informed to the parents through examination answer sheets during the Parent Teachers Meet (PTM). The date of PTM is informed to parents in advance. Parents are invited to go through the answer sheets of the child and collect the report card. Unsatisfactory performance of a student is informed to the parents through the school diary. Parents are requested to check the diaries of the children regularly.

A minimum attendance of 75% in the academic year is required for the student to be eligible for appearing in the final examination.

School conducts adventure trips and picnics for the students every year





## 14. STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

We have Scouts and Guides for the students in our school and the management is also looking to start activities like Unit of NCC and NSS for the students. Yoga classes are to be provided in the school premises. English learning classes are being provided to the students in the school.

## 15. GRIEVANCES AND COMPLAINTS

Since the school is adopting every step to ensure and provide a smooth and quality oriented education to the students and to prepare them to face even the toughest challenges of life, cooperation from the parents is very essential. Without the motivation of the parents no qualitative changes can be assured. Parents are welcome to come to the school for meeting with staff members on Saturdays only. Meeting with the Principal and subject teachers can be fixed between 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. Untimely visits by parents to the school will create disruption in the peaceful school routine; Saturdays from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. will be devoted for attending to the feedback of parents. Every parent is requested to meet teachers at least once in a month as this will be helpful for making a proper assessment about the progress of their child. It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that the children are regular and punctual and are doing the work systematically and carefully.



## 16. RTE Act

The school is committed to implement the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education under the RTE Act passed by the Indian Parliament.

- According to this act, the school will provide complete free education including books, uniform and tuition fee to students in need.
- There will be no segregation of students on the basis of any socio-economic and religious parameter to avail the benefit from the school according to this act.

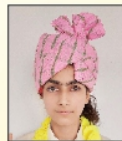

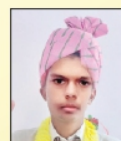

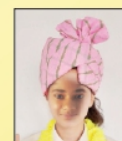
